AISSNG-2024 were held at SS Chandrapur from 21 Sep-01 Oct 2024. Beside winning the gold medals, two athletes have also set a Sainik School record in 100mtr sprint and long jump. The final position of the athletes is as follows:-

The fourth edition of the Inter House Newspaper Reading Contest was conducted on 03 Sep 2024. The contest was started to instil daily newspaper



reading among the cadets. Cdt S Parhasith Reddy of Class X, Godavari house, secured first rank in the contest, and Godavari house won the overall competition. The best cdt is awarded with a Gold medal and the certificate and the winning house receives a gift hamper.

IH DECLAMATION COMPETITION

The second CCA event of the AY 2024-25, the inter house declamation competition was held on 28 Sep 24. The event witnessed the participation of 36 cadets from three age categories in three languages. The school invited six teachers from nearby State Government Schools to judge the competition fairly. School is conducting one CCA event every month and to ensure equal opportunity, one cadet -one CCA per year policy is followed.



IH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The IH Football Championship for the AY 2024-25 was held from 28 Aug-04 Sep 24. The closing ceremony of the IH Football Championship was held on 04 Sep 2024. The competition was played in a league system for all classes, in order to ensure maximum participation by the cadets. The overall championship was won by Krishna house. The best player of the tournament in each category, the boy and girl, were also felicitated during the closing ceremony.



IH BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The IH Basketball Championship for the AY 2024-25 was held from 03 to 27 Aug 2024. The overall championship was won by Krishna house. The closing ceremony coincided with the inspection by Sainik School Amaravathinagar, adding to the event's significance. Principal Amaravathinagar was the chief guest for the closing ceremony and awarded prizes during the ceremony.

ATHLETICS MEET 2024-25

The Annual Athletic Meet of Sainik School Kalikiri for the AY 2024-25 was conducted from 17 to 20 Sep 2024. This is the biggest sporting events of the school and conducted at very large scale every year. Below are some of the highlights of the Annual Athletic Meet-2024:-

- (a) Meet started with the Opening ceremony on PM 17 Sep 24.
- (b) Total 68 competitions were held across 16 disciplines of athletics.
- (c) Around 248 cadets were involved in the conduct of athletics, including 213 athletes/participants (170 boys and 43 girls), and 35 cadet officials in various roles.
- (d) School hired four external coaches/ experts from the State officials to ensure fair judgment and smooth conduct of the event.
- (e) Cadets set 30 new school records in different competitions.



VOCATIONAL LEARNING PROGRAMME

Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP-2020), the school has decided to implement vocational courses for class VI. The following were conducted in Aug-Sep 24:

- (a) Visit to Krishi Vigyan Kendra. The visit aimed to provide hands-on experience in modern agricultural practices and broaden their understanding of farming techniques.
- (b) Kitchen Garden Programme. This activity aimed to provide practical experience in gardening, allowing the cadets to engage in cultivation tasks and develop an appreciation for sustainable practices.
